We, **GDS Präzisionszerspanungs GmbH**, represented by the managing directors **Thomas Löhn and Alexander Seyboldt**, collect and process data for the purpose of **contract implementation and for the fulfilment of our contractual and pre-contractual obligations**. In addition, personal data may also be processed for **direct marketing** purposes.

We collect and store the following data:

- Salutation, if applicable title, first and last name
- Address
- Telephone number (fixed and/or mobile)
- Function or position
- Fax number, if applicable
- E-mail address, if applicable
- Website, if applicable
- Any other data provided or collected

Data collection and data processing is necessary for the execution of contracts and is based on article 6 paragraph 1 b) DSGVO.

In the event that a legitimate economic interest on our part exists, Article 6 para. 1 f) DSGVO is the legal basis. In this case, a weighing of interests is carried out to the full, but without any restriction of the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons. If data are processed on the basis of consent, Article 6 para. 1 a) DSGVO is the legal basis.

Personal data is processed by us for the following purposes:

- Identification of the customer/supplier, trading partner or contact person
- Advice for the customer, trading partner or contact person
- Implementation, administration and processing of orders or projects
- Processing and documentation of activities
- Documentation or proof of agreements and conditions
- Service and complaint handling
- Correspondence
- Invoicing, if necessary dunning process
- Assertion of claims
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Permitted direct advertising

For direct advertising we use the services of the provider „**CleverReach**“ of CleverReach GmbH & Co. KG, Schafjückenweg 2, 26180 Rastede. For this purpose, personal data (e-mail address, name and surname, if applicable) are processed on CleverReach servers, especially for the organization and analysis of newsletter dispatch. Personal data will only be passed on to third parties within the scope of contract fulfillment or to ensure business operations. This includes the transfer to service providers commissioned by us or other third parties whose services are necessary for the execution of the contract. These include, for example, suppliers, trading partners or forwarding agents. Personal data may only be used by third parties for the purposes mentioned above. In addition, contract processors integrated by us, in particular IT and back-office providers, receive personal data if they are necessary for the performance of services. All processors are contractually obliged to treat personal data confidentially and to process it only for the purpose of fulfilling the service.

The data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer required for the purpose of their processing and no legal requirements limit their deletion.

Affected parties have the right to object to the use of their data for direct marketing purposes at any time. In addition, you are entitled to request information about the data we have stored about you. In case of incorrectness, the correction can be demanded. Similarly, affected persons can demand the deletion of their data stored with us, unless legal provisions to the contrary apply. In certain cases it is possible that we restrict the processing upon request.

Consent under data protection law can be revoked at any time.

Those affected can contact us or our data protection officer, Thomas Fromm, at any time with questions about data protection using the contact information provided.

Furthermore, those affected have a right of appeal to the supervisory authority. This is the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information in Baden-Württemberg.
